1. What role did other religions play in your spiritual formation?
2. What do you mean when you say “you were claimed as a Christian?”
3. Baptism seems to play a very significant role in your understanding of faith. Can you say more about that?
4. At one point in the book you say, “I don’t think I have ever stopped calculating mad dashes to catch glimpses of God.” What does that look like for you now?
5. What does being a new creation mean for your identity in and out of the church? Pg. 44
6. What did you “infer about Jesus through the small gestures?”
7. A holy drama of mourning and celebration, death and life constantly at play with one another....p.44
8. You use the term, “groping after God...” that suggests a very particular posture of seeking...can you talk more about that?
9. How do you imagine that people “grope after God” today?
10. Do you make a distinction between spirituality and religion?
11. What place does mystery play in your faith life?
12. Pg 47, “I believe that being a part of the church means giving up any sense of ownership of anything, and any sense of individual rights....”
13. Pg 48- “God is stalking us and preparing us in small but significant ways for the shock of being church and trying to live into the absurdity of church.”
